ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER


The Workgroup on Improved Resolution of Civil Cases was established on October 31, 2019, to make recommendations on the enhancement of civil case management processes in order to deliver justice in a timely, cost-efficient, and accountable manner while maintaining due process. *See In re: Workgroup on Improved Resolution of Civil Cases*, Fla. Admin. Order No. AOSC19-73 (Oct. 31, 2019); *In re: Workgroup on Improved Resolution of Civil Cases*, Fla. Admin. Order No. AOSC20-75 (Aug. 4, 2020).

The Workgroup's term expired on November 19, 2021. The Workgroup worked diligently to submit to the Court its final report of findings and recommendations, together with its proposed amendments to the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, the Florida Small Claims Rules, and the Florida Rules for Certified and Court-

Appointed Mediators. In order to assist the Court in considering the proposed amendments, which the Court is publishing for comments, I hereby reconvene the Workgroup and extend its term through December 22, 2022, for the following purposes: (1) file a response to any comments filed with the Court on the proposed rule amendments; (2) participate in oral argument, which may be scheduled in *In re: Report and Recommendations of the Workgroup on Improved Resolution of Civil Cases*, Case No. SC22-122; and (3) take whatever other action the Chief Justice may direct.


